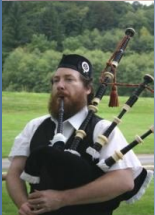
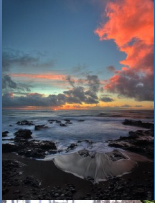
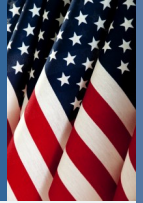


# Memorial Weekend in Yachats

## **HISTORICAL REGIONAL MARKER DEDICATION**

Join members of the OR Historical Marker Committee, Mayor Ron Brean, Chief Warren Brainard of the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Siuslaw Indians, and Tribal Elder and flutist Doc Slyder at Yachats State Park to dedicate a new historical marker representing the Oregon Coast region. The marker notes the region has provided resources for human societies for thousands of years. For all of Oregon's history, Indian tribes and bands stretched along the coast Salmon River, Siletz, Yaquina, Alsea, Siuslaw, Lower Umpqua, and the Coos. The tribal names remain prominently applied to the rivers and estuaries. The regional marker series is managed by the Oregon Travel Information Council (TIC), and if sponsorships are found, all seven regions in the state will be represented. The coast marker was sponsored by the city of Yachats.
